Cargolux selects TRAX eMobility apps



MIAMI, March 12, 2018 - Cargolux Airlines International has signed to implement TRAX eMobility apps. Cargolux is a scheduled and charter air freight provider that uses an all-747 freighter fleet with over 85 offices in 50 countries. Cargolux also offers third-party maintenance services at its Luxembourg hangar. Over the years, innovative concepts and the constant drive for quality have

Cargolux launched its project to roll out the following eMobility apps: TaskControl, QuickTurn and AeroDox iOS apps, supported by the web-based Production Control and Line Control. The apps are fully synchronized with their ERP Trax Maintenance & Engineering system, thus allowing end users access to a paperless environment with real-time information. For example, AeroDox allows maintenance crew to have documents and manuals on a tablet with online and offline access at the point of work. The various apps are intuitive and well-matched to the specific maintenance tasks for AMEs, Crew Chiefs and others. The fact that the apps are fully off-line capable and integrated with their Trax M&E system decreases costs and improves labor efficiency.

The airline and MRO industry are increasingly emphasizing the gains from mobility and the need for smarter maintenance operations. In search of E-signatures and paperless options, they are turning to software such as the TRAX products 'eMRO' and 'eMobility'.
